Redemption Explanation

Redemption Period means that the domain name, which was originally registered in the Network Solutions database, is on hold for approximately 30-calendar-days to give the current registrant the opportunity to reclaim the domain name(s) before being released to others for registration. After this 30-day grace period, the domain(s) will be deleted & again made available for registration to anyone who wishes to do so. A domain is usually deleted because the customer (current registrant) forgot to renew, or just had not renewed the domain in time.

What to do - Current Registrant (Owner)

You have the option to wait until the Redemption Period ends and the domain is again made available on the general market for registration. The domain name is usually free to the public 65 days after the expiration date depending on the registry. With this option you risk losing the domain name to another party.
